## Family Information Sheet

Dear Family Members,

Thank you so much for your support of your family member in the work of spreading Jesus around the world. We make every effort to be as safe as possible and have procedures in case of emergencies. The following sheet is intended to help you reach your team member in the event the need arises. We do our best to maintain contact with home, although sometimes communication can be difficult in third world countries.

As soon as your family member arrives we will contact you by phone or e-mail to let you know we have arrived safely (either from your family member or someone stateside). Give us some flexibility and don't panic if it is more than 24 hours before they can contact you, upon arrival . **Remember, no news is good news.** Communication in Africa can be very difficult.

The best means of communication will be by phone. Malawi is 7 hours ahead of central time. It is best to call when it is lunchtime here in the states. When calling from the states I suggest signing up for an international calling card at [www.callingcards.com](http://www.callingcards.com). Calling Malawi can be as low as .07 cents a minute. Please call only once every three days and limit your calls to 15 min. unless it is an emergency. Please note that the ringing sound may sound like a busy signal.
